## Student Policy and Responsibilities

- Respect for the teacher and other students is expected at all times. Swearing, put downs, class disruptions, and tardiness are considered lack of respect and will not be tolerated.
- Students must show up to class on time.
- Students must leave toys and electronic equipment at home.
- Eating and chewing gum during class is not permitted at any time.
- Cell phones must be turned off for the entire duration of the class.
- YLOC, its staff, nor its facility is not responsible for any lost or damaged items.
- Students must listen carefully to the teacher's directions and ask questions if something is not clear.
- Students must take their assignments with them when they leave the classroom.
- Students must complete the homework assignments carefully and neatly.
- Students are expected to return the homework assignments to the teacher as requested.
- Students must care for and return all school books and materials.
- If a student misses three tutoring class without prior notification, the student will be terminated from the program.
- If a student experiences behavior problems, it may result in the student being terminated from the tutoring program.
- It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian of the student to provide transportation to and from the tutoring location.

**Weapons:** The safety of all YLOC students and staff is of primary importance.
